



FIELD TRIP RULES

REGISTRATION:

- 1) No phone registrations will be accepted.
- 2) Please fill out the Field Trip Agreement and Release Form and return with monies to field trip coordinator, and or e-mail for free field trips (bring Field Trip Agreement and Release with you).
- 3) Field trips are open to MEMBERS of LIGHT of Ohio, Inc. only and grandparents, unless otherwise specified. After a specified cutoff date, Non-member adults will be permitted if there are available spaces.

REGISTRATION FEE:

- 1) Full payment must be included with the registration form. Please make checks payable to LIGHT of Ohio, Inc.
- 2) Checks WILL NOT BE HELD before being cashed.
- 3) A NSF check will result in a \$29.00 fee or most current rate from the bank, and it will put you on a cash basis for all other field trips for the remainder of the year.

CANCELLATIONS:

- 1) Cancellations should be made at least three days prior to the event in order to receive a refund, if available. (Unless otherwise specified).
- 2) To cancel, contact field trip coordinator by phone and by e-mail.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1) All field trips will **start on time**. Please do not expect the rest of the group to wait for you.
- 2) **Please do not bring anyone to an event who was not registered.**
- 3) A parent or a designated parental adult must be present at all events with the children. These events are not "Drop Off" events.
- 4) Supervise your children. Please be sure that your children maintain appropriate conduct during the field trip. For example:
 - a) Do not let your children run ahead. Have them stay with you.
 - b) Listen and follow the instructions of the instructor/leader.
 - c) Do not interrupt the instructor/leader when he/she is talking.
 - d) Do not touch things unless you have been given permission.
 - e) Do not go into areas that are not part of the field trip.
 - f) Etc....
- 5) Dress code. All persons are expected to dress according to the principles of Christian modesty.

The bottom line: Behave in a way that sets a good example for others about HOME SCHOOLING and most importantly, to be a good witness for Jesus Christ.
